

# cuvée 1979



A cuvée of two Riesling varieties from old vineyards planted in 1979 on the Nad Šísary vineyard, where heavy clay soils are interlayered with ancient sea sand. These old vines, with their deep root systems, reach minerals that younger vines cannot access. Growing slowly, they devote their remaining energy to producing concentrated grapes with exceptional character. The result is a beautifully structured, mineral-driven wine with remarkable depth and elegance.
